This interactive and educational experience will explore the roots of Afro-Cuban rhythms, the island's indelible contribution to jazz and popular music in the US, and the history between two nations that has shaped their sounds and stylings across genres and generations.

The delegation will also include a broader introduction to the Cuban people and Cuban health and educational models. Delegates will return with a deeper understanding of the effects of US policies on Cuban music and musicians, and be prepared to more effectively advocate for changes in US policies in solidarity with Cuban artists.
